

Accident Prevention Starts Early

Each summer, the Cleveland Division of Police and the Division of Recreation team up to offer the Child Accident Prevention Program (CAPP).

What is CAPP?

It is a personal safety education course for children ages 4-7. Trained Cleveland Police Officers from the School Education Unit conduct the program.

CAPP's immediate goal is to help children become safer pedestrians, passengers, and eventually safer citizens. The children will learn how to recognize and avoid potential dangers.

The program is taught in a classroom and practice sessions are conducted in a miniature simulated village.

Topics include:

*Recognizing Police Officers as friends
Identification of traffic control devices
How to properly cross the street
Proper use of car seat belts
How to recognize and avoid strangers
Eddie Eagle Gun Safety Education
Bicycle safety
Emergency "911" education*
