City to Begin Issuing Live Tickets for Waste Set Out Violations

Dear Property Owner:

As a reminder, the waste set out violation grace period will end on April 2nd. Since January of this year, property owners in violation of set out guidelines have been receiving citations which were covered by the grace period and did not have fees associated with them. Violations that occur on or after April 3, 2012 will be considered a civil offense and an actionable citation will be issued to the property owner within two weeks of the violation. Residents and property owners with City issued recycling carts may also be cited for failure to recycle or for improperly utilizing the automated cart system.

Please help keep your community free of debris by properly containing your waste and by following waste set out guidelines.
